Be sure to show your Sound Health & Wellness Retiree identification card at Trust Custom Pharmacies or OptumRx pharmacies so that you receive your discount.

Note: If you fill your prescription at a pharmacy that is not part of the OptumRx or Trust Custom Pharmacies, you will need to pay the full cost of your prescription then file a claim with the Trust Office for reimbursement.
